# STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Street Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the East-2 port Street Railway Company which were granted by chapter 3 four hundred and sixty-five of the Laws of eighteen hundred 4 and ninety-seven, and extended by chapter one hundred and 5 seventeen of the Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, 6 and further extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-eight 7 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and 8 one, and further extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-9 four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred 10 and three, are hereby further extended for and during the

period of two years from the seventeenth day of March, nineteen hundred and five, and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted and acquired by virtue of or under
said acts may and shall be exercised in the same manner and
for the same purposes as provided in said chapter four hund red and sixty-five.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the seventeenth of 2 March, nineteen hundred and five.
