IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to continue in force the charter of the Van Buren
Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the
2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Van Buren Trust
4 and Banking Company," as amended by chapter one hundred
5 and thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen
6 hundred and ninety-nine, as extended by chapter three hun-
7 dred and thirty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of
8 nineteen hundred and one, is hereby continued in force, and
9 the persons named in said act as amended and as further
10 amended and continued in force by chapter one hundred and

11 four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
12 and three, is again extended, and the persons named in said
13 act as amended and their associates are hereby given a period
14 of two years from the date of the approval of this act in
15 which to organize and commence business.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
