IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Merchants' Trust Company, and to change the name of some of the corporators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Merchants' Trust Company which were granted by chapter 324 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, approved March 26, 1903, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act, and George C. Wing, Henry P. Cox, Seth M. Carter, George P. Martin, David R. Hastings and Everett L. Smith, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said original act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified therein.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
