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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT in relation to the lands reserved for public uses in the  
Plantation of Kingsbury.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The land agent is hereby authorized and  
2 directed, upon payment to him of the sum of two thousand  
3 seven hundred and fifty dollars, to sell and convey all of the  
4 lands reserved for public uses in the plantation of Kingsbury,  
5 and to release all actions or causes of action which the State  
6 now has or might have for all trespasses heretofore com-  
7 mitted upon said lands. An instrument of conveyance simi-  
8 lar in form to that usually adopted by the agent in the con-  
9 veyance of public lands, shall, when duly executed and deliv-  
10 ered by said land agent, be sufficient to convey title to such  
11 lands and to effectuate such release.

Sect. 2. The proceeds of such sale and release, less all  
2 expenses, costs and expenditures incurred by the land agent  
3 in the recovery thereof and in connection therewith, shall be  
4 deposited with the treasurer of the State to the credit of the  
5 school fund of said plantation of Kingsbury.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
