STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to sell certain public lots in Wallagrass plantation and Eagle Lake plantation, in Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to sell 2 and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in Walla- 3 grass plantation and Eagle Lake plantation, in Aroostook 4 county, constituting part of the school lots of said plantations, 5 if he deems advisable, for such price per acre and on such 6 terms of payment as he may deem advantageous; provided, 7 that in making sales of said lands the legal and equitable 8 rights of persons claiming under said settlers shall be con- 9 sidered and preserved; and provided, also, that the proceeds 10 of any sales made shall be added to the school fund of said 11 plantations.
