*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and eight of the Revised  
2 Statutes in relation to the selection of service of jurors shall  
3 be so construed as to apply to incorporated plantations as  
4 well as to towns and cities.
