IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Shadow pond, so called, in
Squaw Mountain Township, Piscataquis County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Shadow pond, so called,
3 in Squaw Mountain Township, county of Piscataquis, except
4 from June first to August first of each year, and during this
5 period it shall be unlawful to fish except in the ordinary
6 method of angling with artificial flies, or fly fishing.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law for illegal fishing.
