Governor, each year.....	100 00
Lieutenant governor, each year.....	50 00
Agent of tribe, each year.....	400 00
Constable, for police purposes, each year.....	100 00
Roman Catholic priest, each year.....	125 00
Superintendent of farming, each year.....	50 00
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	\$2,625
For interest on Indian Trust Fund.....	\$4,429 70
For annuity (fall dividend)	1,700 00
For shore rentals	3,320 00

Of this amount 10 per cent for municipal purposes.
