

RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy

Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That the sum of twelve hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated for the purpose of rebuilding the house 3 occupied by the Sisters of Mercy at Peter Dana's Point, 4 within the jurisdiction of the Passamaquoddy tribe of 5 Indians, said money to be paid from the fund belonging to 6 the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians now in the State treas-7 ury, said fund being the money received by the State from 8 stumpage and for land sold belonging to said tribe, and that 9 said sum be expended under the direction of the governor 10 and council.
