

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars be appro-

- 2 priated for the year 1905 and five thousand dollars for the
- 3 year 1906, as a special sum to be used so far as may be neces-
- 4 sary by the State Board of Cattle Commissioners, under the
- 5 provisions of chapter nineteen of the Revised Statutes of
- 6 Maine, in preventing the spreading of tuberculosis, glanders,
- 7 and all other contagious diseases among cattle and horses.
