STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to the
2 Maine Industrial School for Girls, six thousand dollars for
3 the year 1905, and six thousand dollars for the year 1906
4 for a general building.

Be there further resolved the sum of one thousand dollars
6 to the said institution for the purpose of grading the grounds.
