STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the expenses of the Maine Industrial
School for Girls.

Resolved, That the sum of twelve thousand dollars be and
2 the same hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hun-
3 dred five and the same for the year nineteen hundred six.
4 And for ordinary repairs and additional help on the farm the
5 sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the
6 year nineteen hundred five and the same for the year nine-
7 teen hundred six. And for electric lighting the sum of five
8 hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen
9 hundred and five and the same for the year nineteen hundred
10 six.
