STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of repairing the bridge across the Narraguagus river in the town of Milbridge.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated, to aid in repairing a bridge across the
3 Narraguagus river in the town of Milbridge, said bridge to
4 be repaired under the direction of the county commissioners
5 of Washington county, and the amounts herein appropriated
6 are to be paid when the governor and council are satisfied
7 that the sum of four thousand dollars has been actually
8 expended for repairs of said bridge by the town of Milbridge.
9 Said sum appropriated and to be paid when the bridge and
10 draw have been completed and not to exceed one-half the
11 amount actually expended for repairing of said bridge by said
12 town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Statement of facts in regard to amount of money paid by the town of Milbridge for support and maintaining of Great bridge across Narraguagus river in said town. Including cost price.

From 1854 to 1892, 38 years.....	\$25,642 13

To complete bridge as has been commenced will cost as follows:

334 feet in length, 24 feet wide and 10 feet deep.	\$12.00 per
lineal foot	\$4,008 00
To raise bridge 1½ feet in height, it requires 256 tons of granite at \$2.50.....	640 00
To fill in the above raise it will require 1,795 tons of granite at \$.50 per ton.....	897 50
