RESOLVE in aid of repairing the bridge across the Narraguagus river in the town of Milbridge.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated, to aid in repairing a bridge across the 3 Narraguagus river in the town of Milbridge, said bridge to 4 be repaired under the direction of the county commissioners 5 of Washington county, and the amounts herein appropriated 6 are to be paid when the governor and council are satisfied 7 that the sum of four thousand dollars has been actually 8 expended for repairs of said bridge by the town of Milbridge. 9 Said sum appropriated and to be paid when the bridge and 10 draw have been completed and not to exceed one-half the 11 amount actually expended for repairing of said bridge by said 12 town.
