STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to legalize the doings of the town of Masardis, in the
county of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The election and qualification and all acts and
2 doings by them performed in their official capacity of the
3 assessors, selectmen and overseers of the poor, treasurer and
4 clerk of the town of Masardis in the county of Aroostook,
5 for the year 1904, is hereby confirmed, legalized and made
6 valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
