IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to organize the plantation of Portage Lake.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Portage Lake plantation formerly township
2 Number Thirteen in Range Six west from the east line of
3 the State in Aroostook county, is hereby made an organized
4 plantation, with all the rights, powers and privileges belong-
5 ing to organized plantations by the law of this State.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
