STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Joseph Long to build and maintain a toll bridge for foot passengers across St. John river at or near Fort Kent, and to build and maintain piers and abutments for supporting said bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Joseph Long of Clair Station in the province
2 of New Brunswick, Canada, is hereby authorized and empow-
3 ered to erect, construct, maintain, manage and use a toll
4 bridge for foot passengers across St. John river, at or near
5 Fort Kent, Maine, opposite Clair Station, New Brunswick,
6 Canada, provided said bridge shall be so constructed and
7 maintained as not to interfere with or obstruct the navigation
8 of said river.

Sect. 2. Said Joseph Long is also empowered to build and
2 maintain piers and abutments on the same place for the pur-
3 pose of supporting said bridge.

Sect. 3. Said Joseph Long is hereby authorized to collect
2 tolls at the rate of five cents for each and every person cross-
3 ing on said bridge.

Sect. 4. The bridging of said river as aforesaid for the
2 purposes herein set forth is hereby approved.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
