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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one is hereby amended by striking out in the ninth line the word "and" and inserting in the tenth line the words 'and two hundred sixteen,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Alexis Morneault of Grand Isle, county of Aroostook in the State of Maine, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to erect and maintain

10 piers and booms on the Saint John river at a point known as  
11 Green island, beginning at Denis Leoque's homestead farm  
12 and extending along lots numbers two hundred four, two  
13 hundred five, two hundred six, two hundred seven, two hun-  
14 dred eight, two hundred nine, two hundred ten, two hundred  
15 eleven, two hundred twelve, two hundred thirteen, two hun-  
16 dred fourteen, two hundred fifteen and two hundred sixteen,  
17 in said town of Grand Isle, for the purpose of sorting and  
18 holding all logs and lumber intended for use in the manu-  
19 facture of lumber at said Alexis Morneault's mill; but in no  
20 way shall they be constructed so as to impede navigation or  
21 to unreasonably obstruct the common use of said river.'
