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AN ACT to incorporate the Farmington Society for the Pre-  
vention of Cruelty to Animals.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

19 associates and successors, are hereby created a body politic  
20 and corporate, by the name of Farmington Society for the  
21 Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, with all the powers and  
22 privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabilities and restric-  
23 tions provided and set forth in all general laws which now  
24 are, or hereafter may be, in force relating to such corpora-  
25 tions; with authority to hold real and personal estate, for the  
26 purposes of the corporation, not exceeding in amount fifty  
27 thousand dollars.

Sect. 2. Either of the first three named incorporators is  
2 authorized to call the first meeting of said society, by mailing  
3 to each incorporator a written or printed notice setting forth  
4 the time and place of holding said meeting, at least seven  
5 days before the time appointed for holding such meeting.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
