IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the bills of expenses of State and County
Officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Every State and county officer whenever required
2 by law to render a bill of expenses, shall itemize the same
3 and make oath, before presenting it for auditing or payment,
4 that it includes only actual cash outlay while in the perform-
5 ance of his official duties.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
