STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of trustees, visiting committees and the board of cattle commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section 1. The trustees of the State School for Boys, of
2 the Maine Industrial School, of the State normal schools, of
3 the insane hospitals and the committee of visitors to such
4 hospitals, of the University of Maine, and the members of
5 the State cattle commission, shall receive from the treasurer
6 of State five dollars per day for their services when employed,
7 and actual travelling expenses.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July,
2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
