## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of certain State officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The secretary of State shall receive an annual 2 salary of two thousand five hundred dollars.

Sect. 2. The insurance commissioner shall receive an 2 annual salary of eighteen hundred dollars. The governor 3 and council may allow such reasonable sum for postage, clerk 4 hire, and actual expenses incurred in the proper enforcement 5 of the laws relating to insurance, as they deem proper. The 6 deputy insurance commissioner shall receive an annual salary 7 of twelve hundred dollars.

Sect. 3. The bank examiner shall receive an annual salary 2 of two thousand five hundred dollars. In addition to his

3 salary he shall receive actual traveling expenses, to be audited4 by the governor and council.

Sect. 4. Said salaries shall be paid quarterly from the State
2 treasury and shall be in full for all official services. Said
3 officers shall collect the legal and usual fees payable to them
4 by virtue of their offices, and account to and pay over the
5 same to the treasurer of State on the first days of January,
6 April, July and October of each year.

Sect. 5. The clerk of the State assessors shall receive an2 annual salary of twelve hundred dollars, payable quarterly3 from the State treasury.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
