IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to compensation of the executive council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Paragraph one of section eleven of chapter one 2 hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, is hereby 3 amended by striking out all after the first sentence of said 4 paragraph, and inserting in its stead the following: 'For ser-5 vices at other sessions of the council each member thereof 6 shall receive twenty dollars for each session, and actual 7 expenses; for authorized services on committees when the 8 council is not in session, and for services on the committee 9 to examine the State prison, each councilor shall receive five

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10 dollars a day and actual expenses;' so that said paragraph as11 amended shall read as follows:

'Each member of the executive council shall receive the 13 same compensation and travel as a representative to the legis-14 lature, for services as a councilor during the session of the 15 council commencing in January and closing immediately 16 after the adjournment of the legislature. For services at 17 other sessions of the council each member thereof shall 18 receive twenty dollars for each session, and actual expenses; 19 for authorized services on committees when the council is not 20 in session, and for services on the committee to examine the 21 State prison, each councilor shall receive five dollars a day 22 and actual expenses.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
