IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the City Trust Company of Bangor, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the City

- 2 Trust Company of Bangor, Maine, which were granted by
- 3 chapter one hundred ninety of the Private and Special Laws
- 4 of nineteen hundred and three, are hereby extended for the
- 5 future period of two years from the approval of this act; and
- 6 the persons named in said act, their associates and successors,
- 7 shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were
- 8 granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner
- 9 and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
