IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing in the tributaries to Little Sebago
lake, in Gray, Raymond and Windham, Cumberland county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries to
3 Little Sebago lake, in the towns of Gray, Raymond and
4 Windham, in the county of Cumberland, under the same pen-
5 alty as is provided under the general law for illegal fishing.
