IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Hancock pond, in the town
of Embden and plantation of Lexington, Somerset county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, or catch
2 any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in Hancock
3 pond, in the town of Embden and plantation of Lexington,
4 in Somerset county.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalty as provided in the gen-
3 eral law of the State for illegal fishing.
