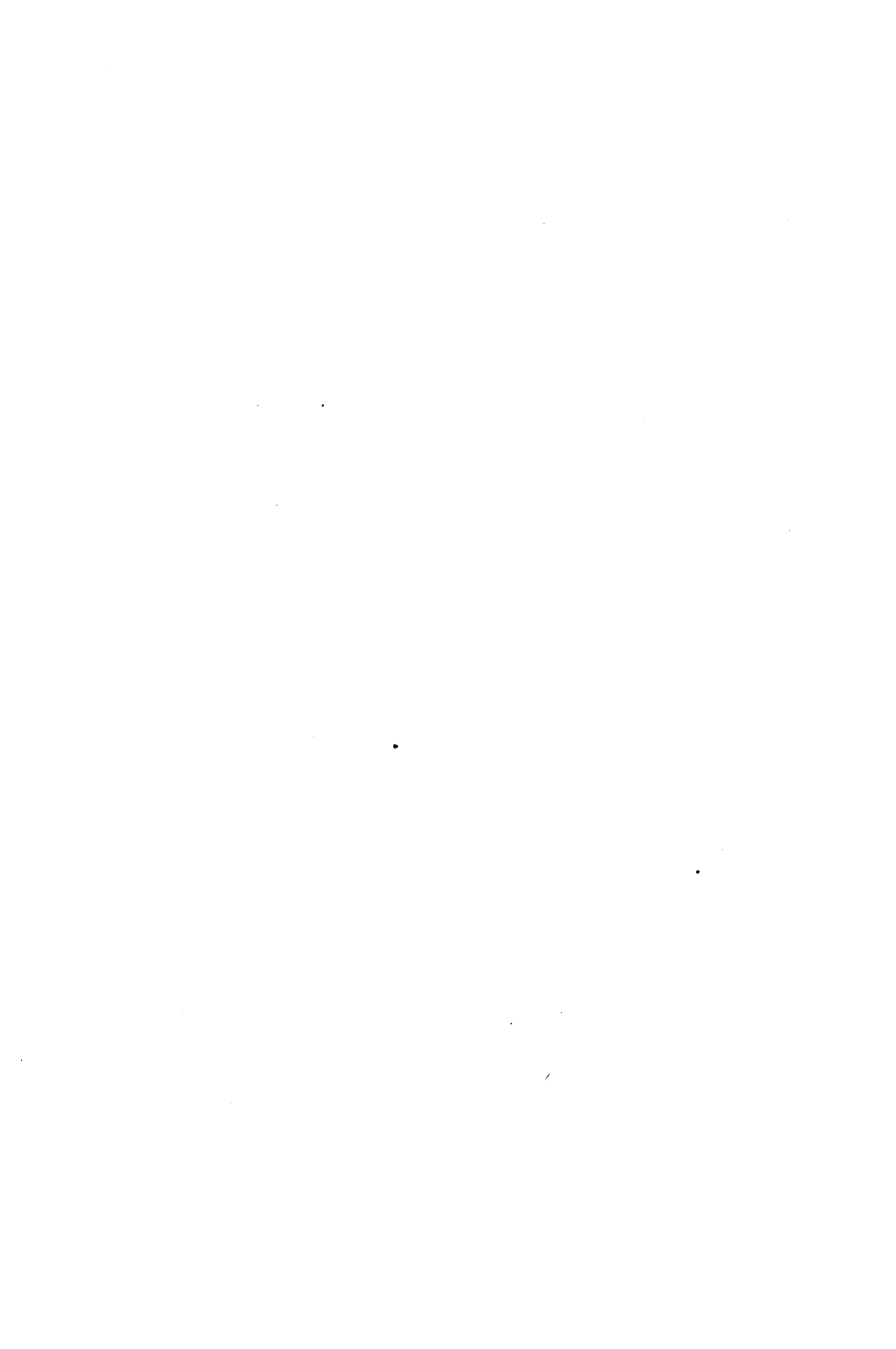
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to permit ice fishing in Half Moon pond, in the county of Oxford, and to permit fishing for pickerel through the ice in Jenne pond, so called, in Mexico and Carthage, partly in Oxford and partly in Franklin county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of paragraph ten of chapter 407 of the
2 Private and Special Laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing in Half
3 Moon pond, in the county of Oxford, through the ice, is
4 hereby repealed, also so much of paragraph five of said sec-
5 tion as prohibits fishing through the ice for pickerel in Jenne
6 pond, so called, in Mexico and Carthage, partly in Oxford
7 and partly in Franklin county, is hereby repealed.
