
AN ACT to extend the charter of the Somerset Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Somer-

- 2 set Trust Company, which were granted by chapter two hun-
- 3 dred and thirty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
- 4 teen hundred and three, are hereby extended for two years
- 5 from the approval of this act, and the persons named in said
- 6 act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
- 7 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
- 8 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
- 9 poses as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
