IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to permit fishing in Branch and Meadow brooks, so called, in Thomaston and Rockland, in accordance with the general law of the State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of paragraph eight of section two of 2 chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun- 3 dred and three as restricts fishing in Branch and Meadow 4 brooks, so called, in Thomaston and Rockland, in the county 5 of Knox, to the month of June in each year, is hereby 6 repealed.
