STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Early York Deeds.

Resolved, That the Maine Genealogical Society, agreeing to
2 supervise the copying, attesting, editing, indexing and pub-
3 lishing of volume fourteen of the public records of this State
4 in the office of the register of deeds for York county, in the
5 same manner as the thirteen preceding volumes already pub-
6 lished, except that, on account of its increased size, it is not
7 required to be leaded, nor to have the tabular index, the gov-
8 ernor and council shall purchase for the State four hundred
9 and fifty copies of said volume at five dollars per volume;
10 and the State librarian shall cause one copy of said volume
11 to be placed in each registry of deeds in this State; and the
12 remaining copies to be distributed or exchanged at the dis-
13 cretion of said librarian.
