## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

---

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to authorize the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to make, generate, use, transmit and sell electricity."

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1 is hereby amended by striking out the word  
2 "county" in the eleventh line and in place thereof inserting  
3 the word 'counties,' and by adding after the word "Penob-  
4 scot" in the eleventh line the words 'and Waldo except in the  
5 city of Belfast,' and by striking out the words "in units of  
6 not less than twenty-five horse power and also for heating

7 purposes but not for electric lighting or street railway pur-  
8 poses," and inserting in place thereof the words 'except that  
9 in the county of Penobscot it shall not be sold in units of less  
10 than twenty-five horse power; and also may sell the same to  
11 any railroad operated by steam, to be used in propelling cars  
12 or trains upon the railroad, and also for heating purposes  
13 but not for electric lighting or for street railway purposes  
14 in the county of Penobscot except to the Public Works Com-  
15 pany or its successors nor in the town of Searsport except  
16 to the Searsport Electric Light Company or its successors.  
17 But nothing herein contained shall prevent any corporation  
18 which may hereafter be organized under the general law from  
19 generating, selling, distributing or supplying electricity in  
20 any of the towns or cities in the county of Waldo,' so that  
21 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company is  
23 hereby specially authorized and empowered to make and gen-  
24 erate electricity upon its property situated upon the Penob-  
25 scot river between the towns of Old Town and Bradley, and  
26 also on any dam or dams which it may erect on its property  
27 situated on said Penobscot river as aforesaid, and to use  
28 said electricity as a motive power in the use and development  
29 of its property, and also to sell the same for manufacturing  
30 and heating purposes and also to carry and conduct electricity  
31 made and generated upon its property between the towns of  
32 Old Town and Bradley to and into any towns or cities in the  
33 counties of Penobscot and Waldo except in the city of Bel-  
34 fast, State of Maine, and to use the same in all ways for its  
35 own purposes, and to sell the same for manufacturing pur-

36 poses, except that in the county of Penobscot it shall not be  
37 sold in units of less than twenty-five horse power ; and also  
38 may sell the same to any railroad operated by steam, to be  
39 used in propelling cars or trains upon the railroad and also  
40 for heating purposes but not for electric lighting or for street  
41 railway purposes in the county of Penobscot except to the  
42 Public Works Company or its successors, nor in the town of  
43 Searsport except to the Searsport Electric Light Company  
44 or its successors. But nothing herein contained shall pre-  
45 vent any corporation which may hereafter be organized under  
46 the general law from generating, selling, distributing or sup-  
47 plying electricity in any of the towns or cities in the county  
48 of Waldo.'
