STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the education of youth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty of chapter fifteen of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "twenty-3 five" in the second line of said section and inserting in place 4 thereof the word 'twenty,' so that said section as amended 5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 40. The school committees of two or more towns 7 having under their care and custody an aggregate of not less 8 than twenty nor more than fifty schools, may unite in the 9 employment of a superintendent of schools, provided they 10 have been so authorized by a vote of their towns at the reg-11 ular town meetings, or special town meetings called for that 12 purpose.' • . · · .
