IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the appointment of an inspector of milk
and vinegar, for the city of Portland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The members of the local board of health of
2 the city of Portland shall annually appoint an inspector of
3 milk and vinegar, who shall, before entering upon his duties,
4 be sworn, and within the limits of said city of Portland, shall,
5 under the direction of said local board of health, perform
6 all the duties imposed upon, and have all the powers vested
7 in, inspectors of milk and inspectors of vinegar, under chap-
8 ter thirty-nine and chapter one hundred and twenty-nine of
9 the Revised Statutes. He shall receive such compensation

10 for his services from the city of Portland as the city council
11 of said city shall fix.

Sect. 2. Said inspector of milk and vinegar shall also have
2 authority to enforce all ordinances of the city of Portland
3 and such by-laws as said board of health may from time to
4 time adopt relating to milk and vinegar and their sale.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
