STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-five of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-six as amended by chapter eighteen of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An Act creating the South Paris Village Corporation."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section second of chapter seventy-five of the
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, as amended
3 by chapter eighteen of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred
4 and seventy-eight, is hereby further amended by adding after
5 the word "force" in the last line of said section as amended,
6 the following words, 'and for the support and maintenance of

7 a library within the limits of said corporation,' so that said
8 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby invested with power
10 at any legal meeting called for the purpose, to raise such
11 sums of money as may be sufficient for the purchase, repair
12 and preservation of one or more fire engines, engine houses,
13 hose, buckets, ladders, or other apparatus for the extinguish-
14 ment of fire, for the construction of reservoirs and aqueducts
15 for the procuring of water, and for organizing and main-
16 taining within the limits of said territory an efficient fire
17 department; also lighting their streets, constructing side-
18 walks, maintaining a night-watch and police force, and for
19 the support and maintenance of a library within the limits
20 of said corporation.'

'Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
