## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the construction and maintenance of a wharf into the tide waters of Casco bay, in the town of Falmouth, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislaiure assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Falmouth Cottage Company, a corporation

- 2 duly organized under the laws of the State of Maine, its suc-
- 3 cessors and assigns, as the owners of certain real estate in
- 4 the town of Falmouth, Maine, are hereby authorized to con-
- 5 struct and maintain a private wharf therefrom into the tide
- 6 waters of Casco bay.
  - Sect. 2. The location and erection of any wharf already
- 2 constructed before the approval of this act by the said Fal-
- 3 mouth Cottage Company as owners of the said real estate

- 4 into the said tide waters of Casco bay are hereby legalized,
- 5 ratified and confirmed, and the said Falmouth Cottage Com-
- 6 pany, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to
- 7 maintain such structure as a private wharf.
  - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
