IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 50 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the alewife fishery in the Pemaquid river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty of chapter forty-one of the Revised Statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by substituting in said section for the
- 3 words eighteen hundred and ninety-five the words nineteen
- 4 hundred and five, so that said section shall read as follows:

'Section 50. From the first day of April to the fifteenth

- 6 day of July in each year, all persons are hereby prohibited
- 7 from fishing with nets, seines, traps, weirs or any other
- 8 contrivance, in that part of Pemaquid river which lies
- 9 between Pemaquid Falls and a line drawn west from the site

10 of the old Pemaquid fort, for the term of ten years from the 11 twelfth day of February, nineteen hundred and five. Any 12 person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be 13 subject to a fine of one hundred dollars, and forfeiture of all 14 boats, nets and apparatus used in such illegal fishing.'
