STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in South Boundary pond, Little
North West pond, Massachusetts bog, in Franklin county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be a close time, for a period of three
2 years from May first, nineteen hundred and five, in which it
3 shall be unlawful to fish for or catch in any way any kind of
4 fish in South Boundary pond, Little North West pond and
5 Massachusetts bog, situated in Township Three, Range Six,
6 W. B. K. P., in the county of Franklin.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided for illegal
3 fishing in the general law of the State.
