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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT relating to the York Light and Heat Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The York Light and Heat Company is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to set, build, extend and maintain  
3 its poles, lines and wires along and upon the public highways  
4 and streets from the cities of Biddeford and Saco, to, into  
5 and through the towns of Dayton, Hollis and Buxton, in the  
6 county of York, and to and into the village of Bonny Eagle,  
7 in the town of Standish, Cumberland county, under such  
8 reasonable restrictions as the municipal officers of said towns  
9 may impose as to the kind of poles, the manner in which they  
10 shall be set and the height at which the wires shall be carried  
11 thereon, for the purpose of supplying light, heat and power

12 in said towns and village, by the manufacture of gas and  
13 electricity as contemplated and authorized by its organization  
14 and charter, and to make and enter into contracts with said  
15 towns, or either of them, for the supplying of light, heat and  
16 power, and to make and enter into contracts for acquiring  
17 power.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
