HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to fishing in the tributaries to Anonymous
Pond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish in the tributaries to
2 Anonymous pond in the town of Harrison subject only to
3 the general laws of the State relating to fishing.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
