

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Western State Normal School at Gorham.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of five thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen 3 hundred and five, and five thousand five hundred dollars for 4 the year nineteen hundred and six for the Western State 5 Normal School at Gorham, the same to be expended by and 6 under the direction of the trustees of the normals schools of

7 the State.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In 1903 an appropriation was made, a larger part of which was to be used toward the construction of an addition to the normal school building. The building has been partially completed, and all of the practice schools are in the addition.

Owing to the increased capacity of the school building, it is necessary to have a larger boiler than the one now in the building.

Four rooms on the second floor of the addition have not been finished, owing to a lack of funds. Two rooms ought to be finished for use in the third story of the school building, as they are very much needed in connection with the work of the school; and the entire building ought to be wired for electric lighting. Six rooms, at least, need furnishing.

The grounds are very much in need of grading.
