STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of repairing Mattawamkeag bridge.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of fifteen hundred dollars to be expended in repairing Matta-
3 wamkeag bridge, so called, situated in Mattawamkeag,
4 Maine. Said appropriation to be expended by an agent to
5 be appointed by the county commissioners of Penobscot
6 county.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Mattawamkeag bridge was built in 1832-3 by the United States and was given to the State of Maine upon the expressed condition that said State should ever afterwards keep the bridge in repair. In accordance with this understanding the State has furnished money for all repairs up to the present. The bridge is a wooden one of the Howe Truss pattern. The repairs needed at present consist of planking throughout, new cross timbers, and the rebuilding of the northeast pier.
