RESOLVE providing for the repair of a roadway in Townships

Five and Six in Piscataquis county.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and

- 2 hereby is appropriated to repair a roadway in Townships
- 3 Number Five and Six in the Ninth Range, lots N. W. P., in
- 4 Piscataquis county. Said appropriation to be expended
- 5 under the direction of the county commissioners of said
- 6 county of Piscataquis.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

That there is in the unorganized townships numbers five and six in the ninth range of lots N. W. P. in said county of Piscataquis a roadway beginning at the north line of the town of Brownville, and thence running in a northwesterly direction to and partially across township number six, aforesaid, to the settlement known as Katahdin Iron Works, that the said Katahdin Iron Works is the terminal of the Katahdin Iron Works branch of the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad; that the said roadway has existed and been in actual use for a period of sixty-seven years; that in its present condition said way is impassable except in winter by reason of want of repair; that no person or municipality is bound to keep the same in repair; that extensive lumbering and manufacturing interests are carried on in said townships and above and that there is no other road or way by which the said settlement can be reached.
