STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 102.

This sum of \$3,000 annually for two years to be used, if necessary, by the State board of health with the consent of the governor and council is in addition to the regular appropriation of \$5,000 per year which was in the first appropriation bill, and is to be used as an emergency fund in case of smallpox or other contagious diseases breaking out in any part of the State, and more especially, in the lumber camps and among the lumbermen in the northern wilderness. Two years ago, there was a sum of \$5,000 in addition to the amount asked for in this resolve appropriated for this purpose.
