## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 53 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, relating to a bounty on seals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 53 of chapter 41 of the Revised Stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section as
- 3 far as the word "no" in the ninth line, so that said section as
- 4 amended shall read as follows: 'No person shall during the
- 5 months of June, July and August destroy seals in the waters
- 6 of Casco bay by shooting with rifle or other long range
- 7 weapon, which might endanger human life, under a penalty
- 8 for any violation of this section, of fifty dollars, to be recov-
- 9 ered upon complaint or indictment, before any court of com-10 petent jurisdiction.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
