IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 53 of chapter 41 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to a bounty on seals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 53 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section as far as the word "no" in the ninth line, so that said section as amended shall read as follows: 'No person shall during the months of June, July and August destroy seals in the waters of Casco bay by shooting with rifle or other long range weapon, which might endanger human life, under a penalty for any violation of this section, of fifty dollars, to be recovered upon complaint or indictment, before any court of competent jurisdiction.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
