STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the maintenance of piers and booms in Baskahegan stream at Danforth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Henry H. Putnam of Danforth, in the county

- 2 of Washington, his successors and assigns, are hereby author-
- 3 ized and empowered to erect and maintain in the Baskahegan
- 4 stream, in said town of Danforth, piers and booms for the
- 5 purpose of collecting and holding logs and other lumber in
- 6 said Baskahegan stream. Said piers and booms shall be
- 7 located as follows:

A boom at Pirch Point, so called, or between said Birch 9 Point and the mill dam in said stream, as said Putnam shall 10 determine, and holding booms upon the easterly side of said 11 stream, extending from the island at the mouth of Crooked 12 brook, so called, to a point at or near the sluice in said dam; 13 and from a point opposite the steam mill, in said Danforth, 14 on the westerly side of said stream and down said westerly 15 side to a point at or near said sluice.

Said piers and booms shall be so located, constructed, main-17 tained and used that logs and other lumber running down 18 said stream, belonging to other parties and not destined for 19 use and manufacture at the mills of said Putnam, his suc-20 cessors and assigns, shall not be unreasonably impeded, or 21 delayed.

Sect. 2. Said Putnam, his successors and assigns, by aid 2 of such piers and booms is hereby authorized and empowered 3 to hold within the piers and booms mentioned in this act, and 4 located, erected and maintained as aforesaid, all logs and 5 other lumber coming down said Baskahegan stream, which 6 are destined and intended for use and manufacture at the 7 mills of said Putnam.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
