STATE OF MAINE.

IN SENATE, February 28, 1905.

Ordered, the House concurring, that the governor and council cause to be compiled, in convenient form, the inland fish and game laws, public, private and special, including all such laws passed by this legislature, and digest of the decisions upon the same, and that ten thousand copies be printed for general distribution, and the governor is authorized to draw his warrant for the payment of the same on the amount appropriated for operating the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for the protection of fish, and fines and license fees received for the protection of game.
