IN SENATE, February 28, 1905.

Ordered, the House concurring, that the governor and coun-2 cil cause to be compiled, in convenient form, the inland fish 3 and game laws, public, private and special, including all such 4 laws passed by this legislature, and digest of the decisions 5 upon the same, and that ten thousand copies be printed for 6 general distribution, and the governor is authorized to draw 7 his warrant for the payment of the same on the amount 8 appropriated for operating the fish hatcheries and feeding 9 stations for fish and for the protection of fish, and fines and 10 license fees received for the protection of game. •
