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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section two of chapter four hundred and six  
of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty,  
entitled "An Act creating the Norway Village Corporation."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That section two of chapter four hundred and  
2 six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and  
3 fifty entitled "An Act creating the Norway Village Corpo-  
4 ration," as amended by chapter one hundred and eighty-six  
5 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and  
6 seventy-five, and by chapter three hundred and nine of the  
7 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, be  
8 and hereby is further amended by striking out the period  
9 after the word "corporation" at the end of section two and

10 inserting in place thereof a comma, and by adding to said  
11 section the following words: 'for the grading and construc-  
12 tion of streets and sidewalks, to provide for a system of sew-  
13 erage, a sufficient police service, to regulate and control signs  
14 hanging over sidewalks, and to adopt by-laws in conformity  
15 herewith not in conflict with the laws of the State of Maine,'  
16 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby invested with power  
18 at any legal meeting called for the purpose, to raise such  
19 sums of money as may be sufficient for the repair and pres-  
20 ervation of one or more fire engines, engine houses, hose,  
21 buckets, ladders or other apparatus for the extinguishment  
22 of fires, for the construction of reservoirs and aqueducts, for  
23 the procuring of water and for organizing and maintaining  
24 within the limits of said territory an efficient fire department,  
25 for the purchase or acquirement, care and maintenance  
26 within the limits of said corporation, of lands for public park  
27 purposes, and for the planting and care of shade trees within  
28 the street limits, and public parks of said corporation, for the  
29 grading and construction of streets and sidewalks, to provide  
30 for a system of sewerage, a sufficient police service, to reg-  
31 ulate and control signs hanging over sidewalks, and to adopt  
32 by-laws in conformity herewith not in conflict with the laws  
33 of the State of Maine.'
