IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to legalize and make valid the acts of Phillips Village
Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The acts and doings of Phillips Village Corpo-
2 ration in their corporation meeting of February fourth, nine-
3 teen hundred and five, relating to obtaining from the legis-
4 lature an amendment to section ten of chapter four hundred
5 and ninety of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
6 dred and eighty-five; and relating to obtaining from the legis-
7 lature authority to purchase the entire works of the Phillips
8 Water Company, are hereby legalized and made valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
